



2026 Australian Historic Road Racing Championship

The Historic Competition Motorcycle Club of WA (HCMC WA) is excited to host the 2026 Australian Historic Road Racing Championship (AHRRC) at Collie Motorplex this September.

The event continues to attract strong support from both long-standing and new sponsors, including WA Tourism South West, which is assisting with promotion through Tourism WA channels.

Adding to the excitement, legendary motorcycle racer Graeme "Croz" Crosby will be the special guest speaker at "A Night with Croz", to be held in Collie on the Friday evening before racing begins. A former World TTF1 Champion, Daytona 200 winner, Isle of Man TT winner, and runner-up in the World 500cc Championship, Crosby's remarkable career spans motorcycle racing, V8 Supercars, and commercial aviation.

A very special machine is heading to Western Australia. The Peter Lodge Racing Norton ES2, part of the Peter Lodge Racing stable and the machine that carried Mike Browne to victory in the 2025 Historic Senior Classic TT, will be flown to Perth immediately following the 2026 Classic TT on the Isle of Man. The winning Norton represents a remarkable piece of classic racing history, giving enthusiasts a rare opportunity to see and hear a genuine Classic TT-winning machine in action against Australia's local finest.

Another heading to Collie Motorplex after the Isle of Man will be Kev Stephens who will be racing fresh off another Classic TT.

Travel Rebates



HCMCWA announced that Turn 1 Motorsports is sponsoring a program of cash travel rebates for eligible interstate competitors coming to WA's premier road racing circuit.

Rebate amounts by state of residence:

- QLD, NT, NSW, Tasmania, and New Zealand: \$550 per competitor
 - Victoria: \$500 per competitor
 - South Australia: \$450 per competitor
- Example given: if three competitors from QLD share transport, you would receive a combined \$1,650 total rebate.

Claims are to be made via the HCMCWA website and will be reimbursed following the event.

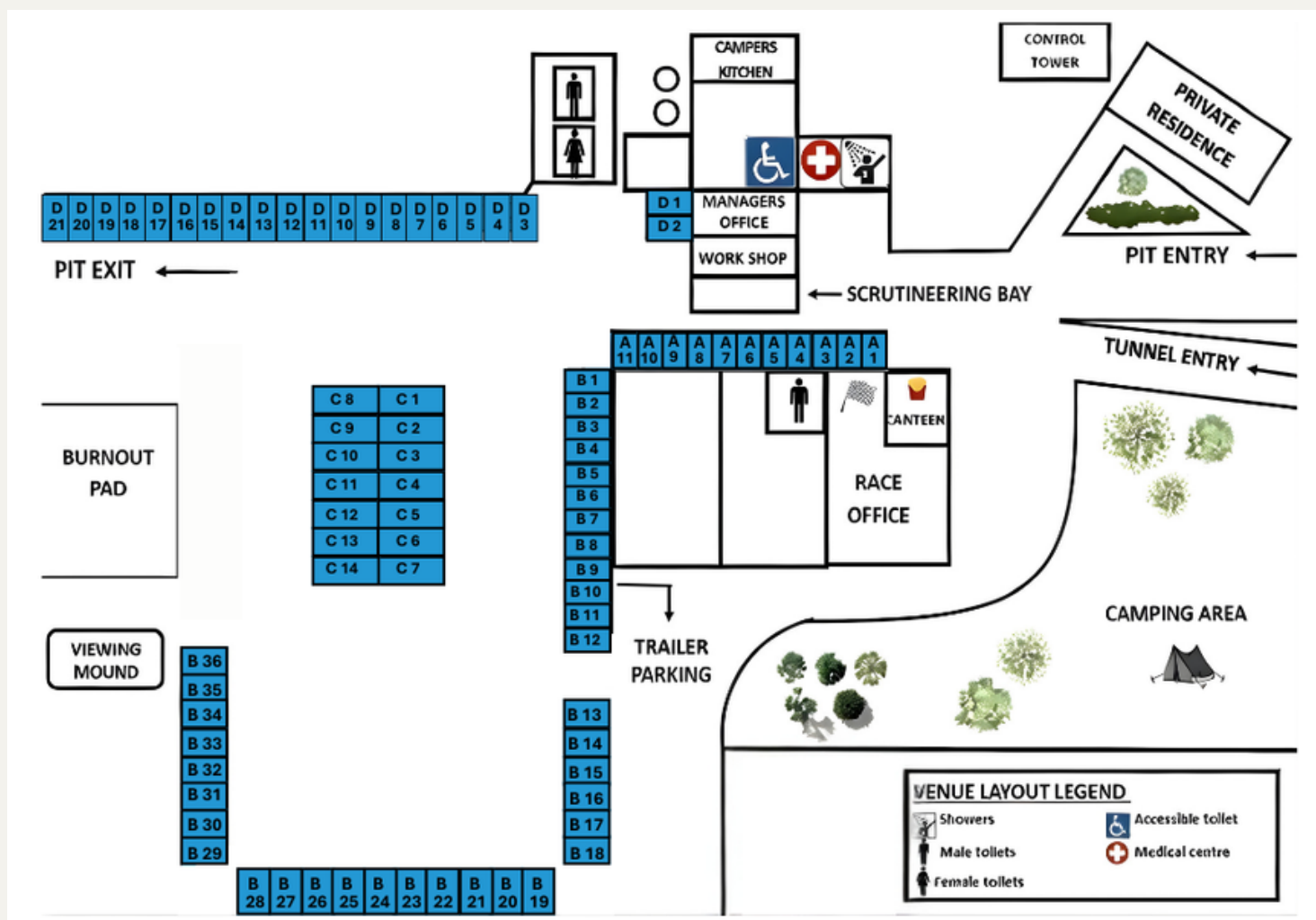

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PIT INFORMATION



Collie Motorplex has recently undergone several upgrades, including resurfacing of the pit area, new carport-style pit bays, track repairs in selected areas and electrical infrastructure upgrades. Pit allocations will occur once entries close.

In addition, HCMCWA will provide supplementary power through generators to help ensure a reliable power supply throughout the event. In the past, items such as kettles have overloaded circuits and caused power outages within the pit area. The additional power arrangements are intended to minimise these issues.

There will be no restrictions on the use of tyre warmers or motorcycle starters. Please note that vehicles other than competitors' motorcycles and pit crew vehicles will not be permitted in the main pit area.

There will be several food options including a canteen, food vans and a coffee van.

All competitors must exercise extreme care when entering and exiting the circuit as members of the general public are able to freely move throughout the pit area. Your cooperation will help ensure a safe and enjoyable event for all participants and spectators.

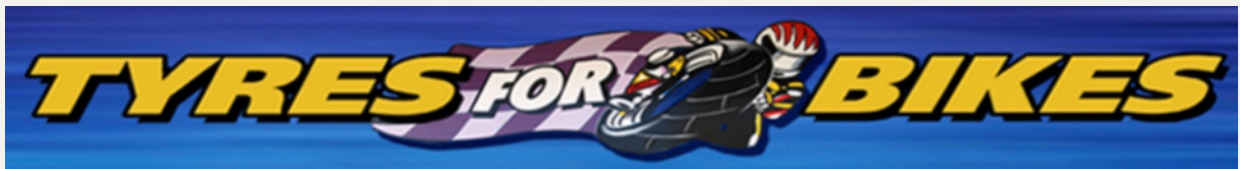
A tyre fitting machine is also available at the circuit for competitor use.

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Things To Do

If you're visiting Collie, WA in September you're arriving at one of the best times of year. Spring brings warmer weather, flowing waterways, and spectacular wildflowers. Here are the highlights:

Wildflowers in Wellington National Park
September and October are peak wildflower months. The jarrah forests around Wellington National Park come alive with orchids, wattles, banksias, and many other native species.

Wellington Dam Mega Mural

The enormous "Reflections" mural by Guido van Helten covers around 8,000 square metres of the dam wall and is regarded as one of the world's largest dam murals. Spring is ideal for viewing and photography.

Walk Across the Wellington Dam Walkway

The elevated walkway provides unique views of the mural, reservoir, and surrounding forest. It's open daily and offers fantastic photo opportunities.

Collie Mural Trail

Explore more than 40 murals throughout the town and surrounding area. The trail connects Collie's history, mining heritage, culture, and natural environment through public art.



Honeymoon Pool

One of the South West's most picturesque spots, featuring calm river pools, picnic areas, and walking trails surrounded by forest. Spring weather is perfect for relaxing by the water.

Long Pool

A beautiful section of the Collie River popular for swimming, kayaking, and picnics when the weather starts warming up.

Mountain Biking Trails

Collie has become one of WA's premier mountain biking destinations, with extensive trail networks in Wellington National Park suitable for beginners to advanced riders.

Sika Trail and Bushwalks

Spring is ideal for hiking. The Sika Trail, Jabitj Walk, and other forest tracks offer great scenery, birdlife, and wildflowers.

Potters Gorge

Located on Wellington Dam, it's great for kayaking, canoeing, fishing, walking, and lakeside picnics during spring.

Wellington Dam Lookout

Visit late afternoon for panoramic views over the dam, mural, and forests. Spring sunsets can be spectacular.

Trailer Parking

Secure Trailer Parking & Competitor Support Facilities

Thanks to the generosity of a local club member, competitors will have access to a secure rural property located just 5 minutes from Collie Motorplex. The property features locked-gate access and a discreet location, providing a safe and convenient option for trailer and transporter storage before and/or after the event.

To further support competitors, a range of workshop equipment will also be available trackside, including:

- Welders
- Hydraulic presses
- Fabrication tools
- General repair equipment

These facilities are provided to assist competitors with maintenance and repairs throughout the event weekend, helping to keep everyone on track and racing.



Accommodation

If you're planning a trip to Collie it's a popular time due to the mild spring weather and wildflowers, so booking early is recommended. Here are some good accommodation options:

Black Diamond Lodge

Late September can become busy with visitors heading to Wellington National Park, Black Diamond Lake, Stockton Lake, and the Munda Biddi Trail, so aim to secure accommodation several weeks ahead.

If you're happy to stay in Bunbury and drive to Collie, you'll have many more accommodation choices. The drive is approximately 55-60 km and takes about 40-45 minutes each way.

Booking.com and Airbnb often have a range of accommodation options available, and availability can change daily. Hotels in the area are frequently booked well in advance by mining companies for shutdowns however rooms often become available closer to the event date when they are no longer required. A number of properties have already been secured, so rest assured that everyone will be accommodated. Camping at the track offers the best experience and is highly recommended, even if it's only for a night or two.

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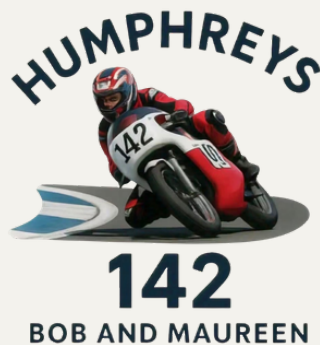
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
